CLASS & DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS

Elementary Hunter / Equitation (Unrated Division)

Open to green horses (in hunter section only) and/or novice riders eligible for Walt Trot and Short Stirrup. To show at walk and trot only on the Flat. Fences no higher than 18". Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6.

Short Stirrup Hunter (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 12 years of age or under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". Under Saddle class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Classes 7, 8, & 9. Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once.

Short Stirrup Equitation (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 12 years of age or under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". On the Flat class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Classes 10, 11, & 12. Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once.

Walk Trot (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Horses and Ponies. Open to Riders 10 years of age and under who have not shown in any class that requires a canter. Rider must show in Class 11 to show in Class 12. Classes 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, & 28.

Hunter Type Pet Pony (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 14 years of age or under. To show at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manner, performance and suitability. Rider must show in Class 29 to show in Class 30. Classes 29 & 30.

Lead Line (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 6 years of age and under. To show collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader on foot must be 14 years of age and/or over. Rider may only compete in this class. 14, 15, & 16.

Long Stirrup Hunter / Equitation

Open to riders 13 years of age and over. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". On the Flat classes will show at walk trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Classes 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, & 22.

Hunter Pleasure (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to all Horses of the Hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitation to the status of the Rider. To show at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the Horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness. Rider must show in Class 31 to show in Class 32. Classes 31, 32.

NEHC Pleasure Class (NEHC Rated "C")

Open to horses and ponies to be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Class #33.

Modified Hunter

Open to horses and ponies. No restriction to age or status of rider. Fences 2'. Classes 34, 35, & 36.

Modified Children's / Adult Hunter

Open to horses and ponies. Ridden by Amateur Adults and Juniors who have not jumped 2'6" or higher in the previous year. Fences 2'. Classes 37, 38 & 39.

Low Hunter

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on age or status of rider. Fences 2'. Class 40, 41, & 42.

School Horse Equitation

Open to Amateur Adults and Juniors riding horses / ponies currently being used in a lesson program . Fences 2'. Classes 43, 44, & 45.

Children's / Adult Special Hunter (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult and Junior Riders. No Professionals. Open to Horses and Ponies that have not jumped 3' or over in the previous year, OR Riders who have not shown at 3' or over in the previous year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". No in and outs. Classes 46, 47 & 48.

Children's Equitation (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders who are eligible for Children's Hunter who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3'. Fences 2' for small and medium Ponies, 2'6" for large Ponies and Horses. Classes 52, 53 & 54.

Children's Hunter Horse (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Junior Riders 15 to 17 years of age, must be eligible for Intermediate Equitation over Fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' for small and medium Ponies, 2'6" for large Ponies, 3' for Horses; spreads not to exceed fence height. Same Horse/Pony-Rider combination may not show in any other rated division except Equitation at the show. Horses may be shown by another Rider in any other division. To show at a walk, trot and canter. Classes 74, 75 & 76.

Children's Hunter Pony (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Same as Children's Hunter Horse. Classes 49, 51 & 51.

Modified Adult Hunter (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Horses and Ponies ridden by Amateur Adult Riders. Fences 2'3" to 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Amateur Adult Hunter Division. Classes 58, 59 & 60.

Amateur Adult Hunter (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult Riders. To show at a walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 3' with spreads not to exceed Fence height. Classes 65, 66 & 67.

Amateur Adult Equitation (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult Riders. Fences 3'. Classes 68, 69, & 70.

Open Equitation Division (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Junior riders. Fences 3'. Classes 77, 78 & 79.

MHC Mini Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and who have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. 6 to 8 Fences not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. A Mini Medal Rider who competes in the Jr. Medal is no longer eligible to compete in the Mini Medal Division. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 56.

MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. 10 points are needed to qualify for Finals. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 80.

NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 82.

Bay State Medal

Open to Amateur Adult Riders. Course requires at least 8 Fences not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 63.

MHC Adult Hunter Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of MHC. Course requires 8 Fences 2'6" to 2'9" with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 71

NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of NEHC. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 73.
